THE TRUTH ABOUT GRACE!

Dear Partner,

The apostle Paul wrote,

For it is by free grace (God's unmerited favor) that you are saved (delivered from judgment and made partakers of Christ's salvation) through [your] faith. And this [salvation] is not of yourselves [of your own doing, it came not through your own striving], but it is the gift of God. Ephesians 2:8 AMPC emphasis mine
